KCTCS 2022-2026 STRATEGIC PLAN

The current KCTCS strategic plan ends June 30, 2026.

A new plan must be developed and approved by July 1, 2026.





HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

- Strategic plans developed in sixyear cycles.
- Aligns with legislative and KCTCS budget cycles.
- Includes goals, objectives, key performance indicators, and targets.
- Aligns with statewide goals and priorities.
- Approved by the KCTCS Board of Regents.

CURRENT STRATEGIC PLAN

- KCTCS leadership and Board of Regents made the decision to adopt two four-year strategic plans: 2022-2026 and 2026-2030.
 - Enhances alignment with CPE Strategic Agenda which runs through 2030.
 - Allows KCTCS to be nimble and more responsive to workforce partners and other stakeholders.

ACTION PLANS

- Two-year action plans (formerly business plans) developed with specific strategies to help achieve strategic plan goals, objectives, and targets.
 - Approved by the KCTCS President and President's Leadership Team.


COLLEGE PLANNING
