RESOLUTION TO APPROVE USE OF SAFE SCHOOL ID

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of _____ School District No. _____, County of _____, State of Illinois, ("the Board") has the responsibility to ensure a safe school building for students and its employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board works with its vendors and contractors to act in compliance with the law and to perform appropriate background checks on adults who come into contact with children during the school day; and

WHEREAS, in addition to what is required by law, the Board is always seeking new ways to enhance the safety programs of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Safe School ID ("SSID") program will provide another layer of protection for staff and students within the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, It Is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Education of _____ School District No. _____, County of _____, State of Illinois as follows:

Section 1. The recitals of this Resolution are adopted and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Effective _____, the Board will require the SSID program check for the following individuals (list if known; or say all non-employee vendors, contractors, and sub-contractors): _____.

Section 3. The individuals will be prohibited from being on District grounds without first completing the SSID program check. The SSID program check will require a background review and, upon successful completion of the review, these individuals will receive a SSID clearance credential that must be scanned upon entering District property. While on District property, the individual must also carry a valid state or US government issued photo identification.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
