STAFF CARRY ON TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Soccer - The soccer complex reached substantial completion and our students are now utilizing the field. This work included the new turf field (new subgrade, geobase, shock pad, turf, and cooling mineral), new score board, and new bleachers pad.



High School Addition - the foundation is set, steel structure finishing up, and crews are beginning to place to steel decking (base layer of roof).



Rocket Booster Stadium - Work is in full swing. The new scoreboard is in place, new lights in place, the field subgrade and geobase are finished, the entryway is under construction, and the new visiting locker room footings are in place. Crews are schedule to start working on the track and playing field in the coming weeks.





Scoreboards - All new scoreboards are in place except softball. That one is being build and is anticipated to be installed in the near future. That board will be the same one that is picture to the left and which was installed at the baseball field.
