## Items of Interest:

- Port Beta Project
  - RBC has developed all the fiber
  - RBC is working on splicing
- Damage to QLIFE fiber along 2700 block of East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street
  - A dump truck hit the fiber line and pulled the fiber down to the ground along about 6
     pole spans
  - Traffic was driving over the fiber (which was laying on the ground perpendicular across the highway)
  - A local fiber construction company was contracted under emergency procurement policies due to both safety concerns as well as the impact (and potential impact) to QLIFE customers.
  - The local fiber construction company (with the help of ODOT providing traffic control) was able to secure the fiber back onto the pole line and out of harm's way within a few hours.
  - Some customers experienced blips of service for approximately 1 ½ hours as traffic was driving over the fiber.
  - This fiber section will need to be replaced under scheduled maintenance.
- OLIFE was called out on Sunday afternoon (memorial weekend) regarding a tree that had taken out a telecommunication line at West 3<sup>rd</sup> place. This telecommunications line was laying on the road across both traffic lanes. The local municipal had shut down the street due to safety concerns.
  - We were able to identify that it was not QLIFE fiber that had been damaged (QLIFE fiber was on the other side of the street), and we were able to help identify who the owner was. Additionally, we were able to use our contacts to help inform the owner of the situation.
