Readopt with amendment Ch 103.02, effective 9/11/07 (Document #8971), to read as follows:

Ch 103.02 <u>Officers</u>. The board officers shall consist of a chairperson and a vice chairperson elected by the board at a regularly scheduled board meeting, at a minimum, once every 2 years.

Repeal Ch 103.03, effective 6/27/01 (Document #7516), as follows:

[Ch 103.03 Staff. There is an administrative assistant designated by the board and there are such other staff members as are necessary to perform the record-keeping and other statutory functions of the board and to oversee the board's day-to-day operations.]

Adopt Ch 103.03 to read as follows:

Ch 103.03 Board Member Ethics. No board member shall:

- (a) Participate in any action related to the issuance of a license or disciplinary matter involving such board member or a person with whom the board member is personally or professionally associated; and
- (b) Serve as an officer of a professional association which represents practitioners of any occupation or profession under the jurisdiction of the board.

Readopt with amendment Ch 104.01, effective 6/27/01 (document #7516), to read as follows:

PART Ch 104 PUBLIC REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION

Ch 104.01 Office Location, Telephone Number, Number for TTY/TDD Users, and Mailing Address.

- (a) The board's office is located at the office of professional licensure and certification (OPLC), 7 Eagle Square, Concord, New Hampshire.
 - (b) The OPLC main telephone number is (603) 271-2152.
- (c) In-state TTY/TDD users may reach the office by calling Relay New Hampshire at 711 or 1 (800) 735-2964.
 - (d) Requests for information, including board records, shall be made in accordance with Plc 103.
- (e) Requests for information, written submissions to the board, and other correspondence shall be addressed as follows:

Repeal Ch 104.02, effective 6/27/01 (Document #7516), as follows:

[Ch 104.02 Inspection and Copies of Public Records.

- (a) Pursuant to RSA 91-A:4 members of the public shall have the right to inspect and copy the public records of the board, including all meeting minutes not confidential pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, III.
- (b) Members of the public may inspect such public records at the office of the board.
- (c) Persons desiring copies of such public records shall:
 - (1) Submit a request in writing which identifies as particularly as possible the information being sought; and
 - (2) Pay the actual cost of the copies.
- (d) If records are requested which contain both public information and information exempt from disclosure pursuant to RSA 91-A or any other law, the board shall delete the information which is exempt from disclosure and provide the remaining information.
