ASWSU'S TOP INITIATIVES:

- **Basic Needs – Food Security, Housing Accessibility, and Mental Health Awareness**
 - **Food Security**
 - Host a canned food drive in the Fall and Spring semesters
 - Donate all collected food to Cougar Food Pantry and Pullman's Food Bank
 - **Housing Accessibility**
 - Host a housing fair in the Fall and Spring semesters
 - Potentially working on going into residence halls to speak to our first year students about leases to help ease the process of signing one
 - **Mental Health Awareness**
 - Maintaining our strong connection with Cougar Health Services and working with them on the Mental Health Symposium
 - Tabling & hosting events during Mental Health Awareness month and during Prep Week
- **Transportation**
