- Masters Entry to Professional Nursing Degree Program (MEPN) Funding would establish the state's first 14-month-long MEPN program for students already holding a Bachelor's degree to increase the supply of licensed nurses and nurse educators. Request amount: \$1.4 million annually
- WSU ROAR stabilization and expansion
 Funding would replace an expiring federal grant and expand the
 College of Education's signature program to promote independent
 living and job skills for students with intellectual and developmental
 disabilities in a residential setting on the Pullman campus.
 Request amount: \$600,000 annually
