Minor Capital Renewal (MCR) and State Minor Capital Improvement (MCI) projects, and delegate to the President or their designee the authority to group these minor capital projects into contracts that may exceed \$5M for the purpose of procurement and execution efficiency.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION:

Washington State University's 2025-27 state capital budget aligns capital investment with the system's priorities in teaching, research and outreach.

There are two general categories of state capital funding: Preservation and Program Improvement for individual projects under \$2M.

The state capital request places a high priority on maintaining and preserving capital investments of university facilities systemwide. Limited funding for capital renewal and ongoing reductions in operating budgets have contributed to a growing deferred maintenance backlog, currently estimated at \$1.8B.

WSU's growing deferred maintenance backlog of renewal and preservation requirements are most often addressed through minor works, which remains WSU's top priority in the capital budget.

Minor works projects typically address deferred maintenance, system-wide in these areas. Pending funding levels, public works contracts will be bundled around these categories. We expect most of these contracts will exceed \$5M each.

- Elevator/conveyances component replacement, repair, and upgrades
- Life safety/code compliance; security; environmental; public and employee liability & safety
- HVAC and Building Automation System controls
- Electricity, sewer, steam, and water distribution systems renewal
- Mechanical systems, compressors and pump replacements and renewals
- Network and communication infrastructure
- Roofs, exterior masonry/painting, restoration, window/door replacement and
- repairs
