IndyGo intends to address passenger misconduct through improved education and increased enforcement of IndyGo's code of conduct.




IndyGo will work to better understand existing laws impacting employee and rider safety and explore opportunities to modify or enact new protections.



Customer Perception of Safety and Security


- Results of 850+

- Nearly 80% of customers responding felt safe riding the bus






Customer Perception of Safety and Security

- Majority of respondents said they did not feel harassed while riding the bus
- 19% responded that they are harassed on Every Trip
- 19% responded that they have witnessed someone else being harassed on Every Trip



Customer Perception of Safety and Security

- 69% of respondents reported no experience of harassment
- Approx. 15% respondents reported having experienced verbal threats
- Fewer than 10% reported experiencing sexual, racial, or physical harassment







Employee Perception of Safety and Security – 160+ respondents

These tools have been useful in promoting safety and positively impacted my perception of being safe.








FTA Definition on Transit Worker Assault:

Assault on a transit worker means, as defined under 49 U.S.C. 5302, a circumstance in which an individual knowingly, without lawful authority or permission, and with intent to endanger the safety of any individual, or with a reckless disregard for the safety of human life, interferes with, disables, or incapacitates a transit worker while the transit worker is performing the duties of the transit worker.




 Contracted Law Enforcement Contacts on Fixed Route Services for 2023-2024




 Contracted Law Enforcement Contacts on BRT Route for 2023-2024













- Criminal Activity Includes

 - Loitering has the highest volume at 3,318 for 2024.














Proactive Surveillance

 - Work with the dispatchers to be more proactive instead of reactive to issues on the platforms





