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Executive Summary

Route Changes

- **Route 39 was replaced by Purple Line in Bid 2410.**
- Route 18, 86 retired after Bid 2406.
- Route 2, 25 (60 to 30 min), Route 10 (20 to 15 min), Route 11 (90 to 30) on weekdays from Bid 2406.
- Route 8 WH to the Airport – every 30 min, WH to Meijer every 15 min.
- Route 901 & 902 replaced by 82 & 29 resp, Route 30 (45 to 30 min on Weekdays) from Bid 2410.

On Time Performance

- **All System On Time Performance at 80%.**
- Coverage Service On Time Performance at 81%
- Basic Service On Time Performance at 80%
- Frequent Service On Time Performance at 79%
- Rapid Lines (Red and Purple Line) On Time Performance at 76%

Ridership

- **Total Boardings at 6,964,264 with Average Weekday Boardings at 22,336.**
- Coverage Service Average Weekday Boardings per Revenue Hour was 15.24
- Basic Service Average Weekday Boardings per Revenue Hour was 8.68
- Frequent Service Average Weekday Boardings per Revenue Hour was 9.47
- Rapid Service (Red and Purple Line) Average Weekday Boardings per Revenue Hour was 20.99
- ***2024 ridership (excluding BRT) appears low due to MyKey route level issues from September 2024.**
- **A total of 84,541 rider entries couldn't be attributed to a specific route (excluding BRT) in 2024, due to missing route info in GFI and MyKey data. But they are included in the Total Boarding data.**

- **Total Clients were 169,074 which includes passenger trips, attendance, companions and others**

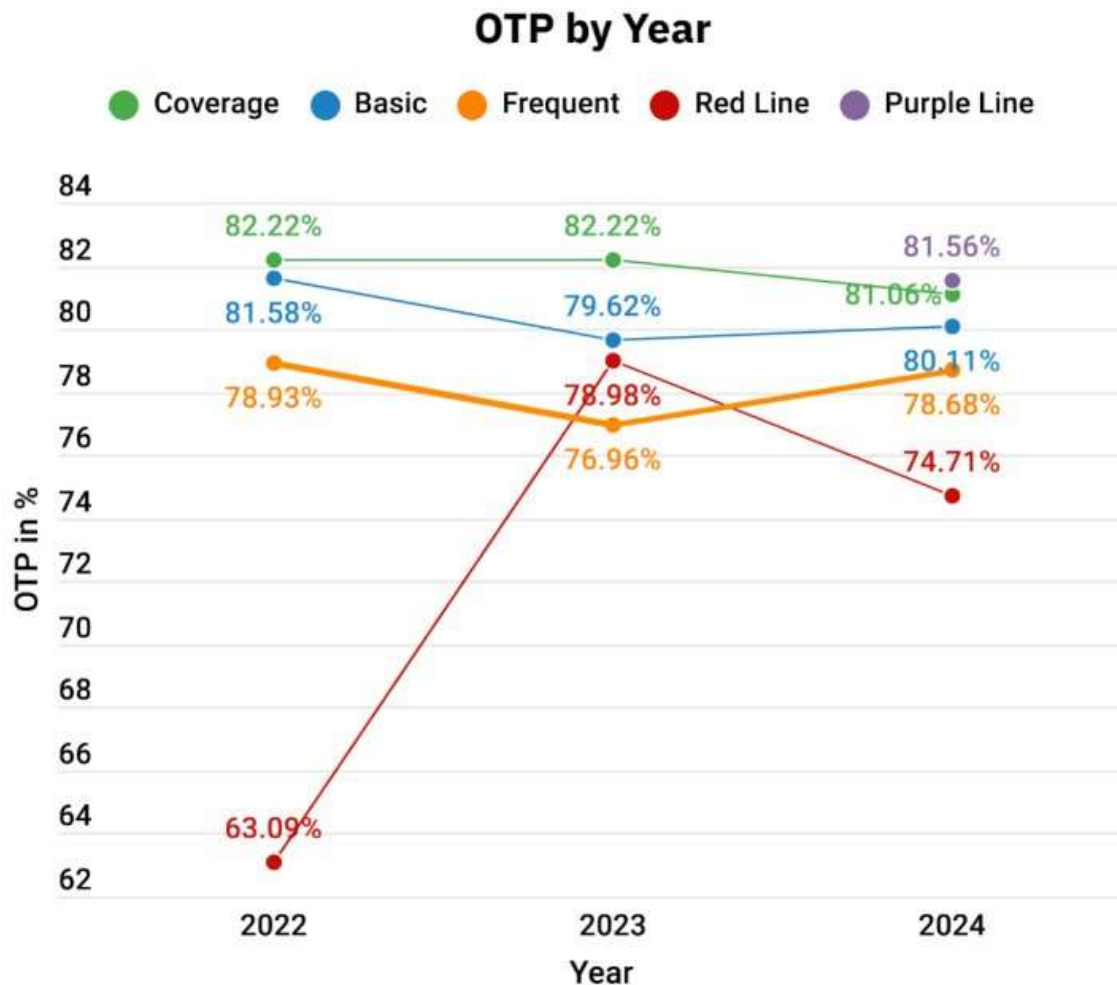

Fixed Route KPI's

On Time Performance

The overall system OTP remained consistent with previous years, holding steady at 80%. However, the 4.27% decrease in performance on the Red Line, along with a low OTP for Frequent Services, had a significant impact on the overall systemwide OTP.



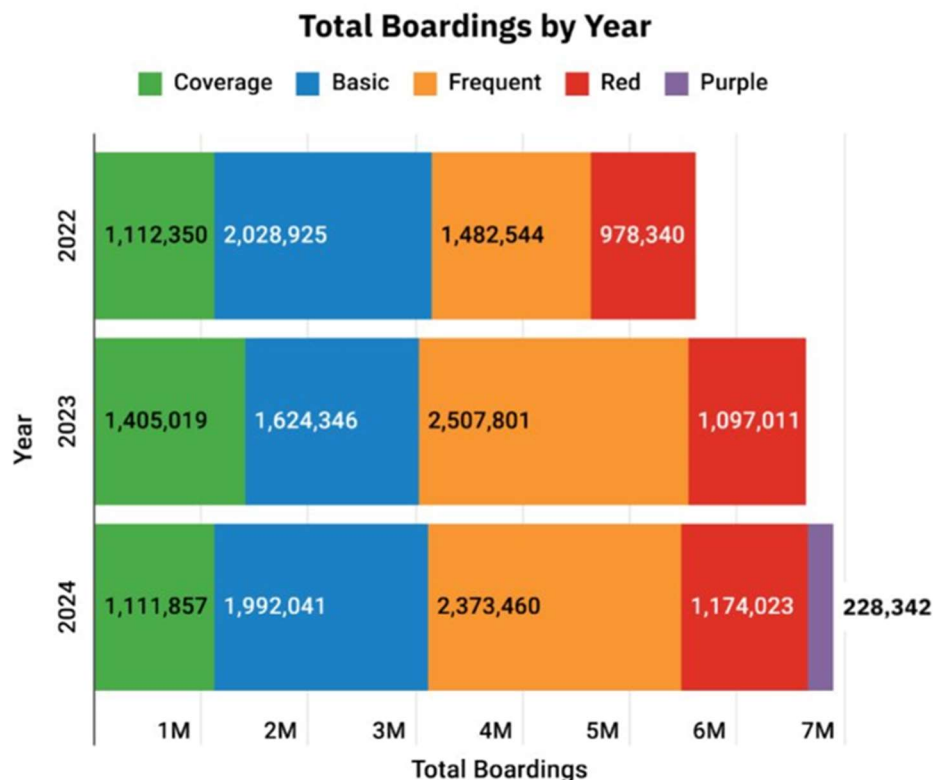

Ridership

In 2024, total boardings reached 6,964,264, reflecting an average weekday boarding of 22,336, which represents a 3.5% increase from 2023. The Rapid Red line (10-minute frequency) saw a strong upward trend, with boardings growing to 1,174,023, up from 1,097,011 in 2023.

The Basic service (30-minute frequency) also experienced significant growth, though still less than when compared to 2022, reaching 1,992,041 boardings in 2024. In contrast, both the Frequent (15-minute frequency) and Coverage (60-minute frequency) services experienced slight decreases in boardings compared to 2023.

Post-launch of the Purple Line in October 2024, it has effectively catered to riders, with 228,342 boardings recorded from October to December 2024.



Overall, while demand continued to grow for Rapid Red and Basic services, there were subtle shifts in ridership, with a slight drop in the Basic and Coverage services.

Weekday Boardings per Revenue Hour

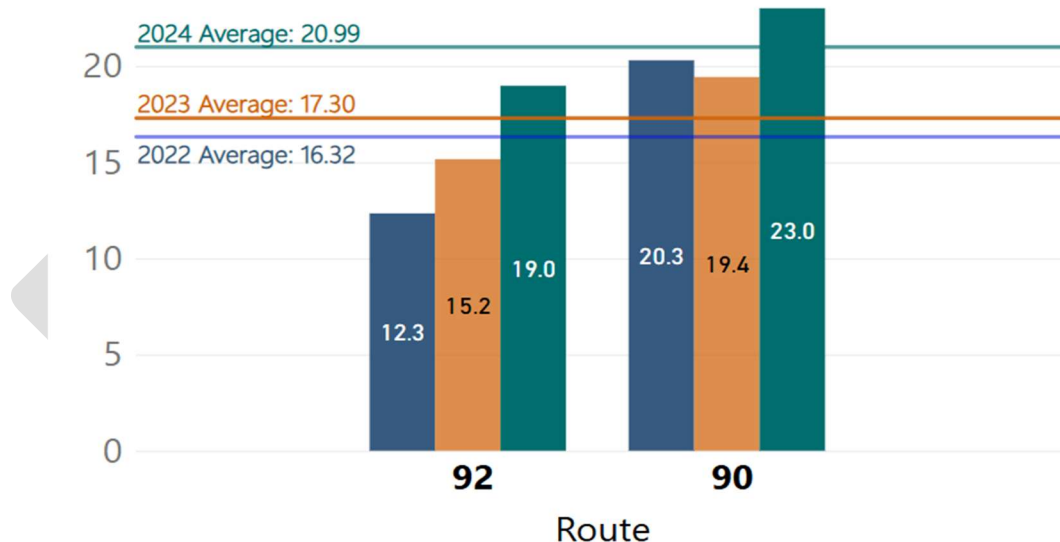
Rapid

For Rapid routes, the Average boardings per revenue hour increased by 3.69 (21.3%) in 2024 vs 2023 and has shown continuous improvement since 2022. Route 90 showed a significant increase in 2024.

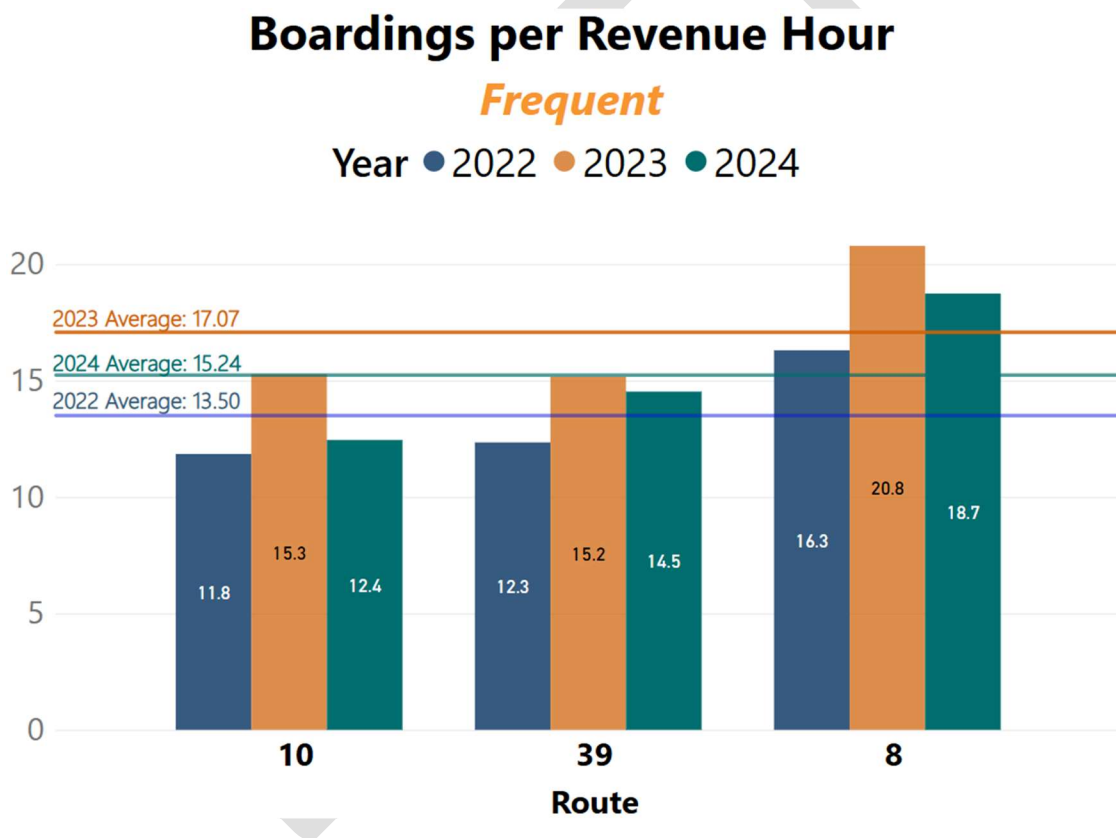
Year ● 2022 ● 2023 ● 2024



Note: Route 92 was introduced in 2024 and largely replaced Route 39. In the graph above, 2022 and 2023 data for Route 39 is therefore provided as comparison to Route 92's 2024 data. It is important to note however that this is not a 1:1 comparison. While the Purple Line is comprised primarily of Route 39, it also overlaps with service from Routes 2, 4, 87, and the portion of the Red Line between 38th St and downtown. Route 30 has incorporated portions of Route 39.

Frequent

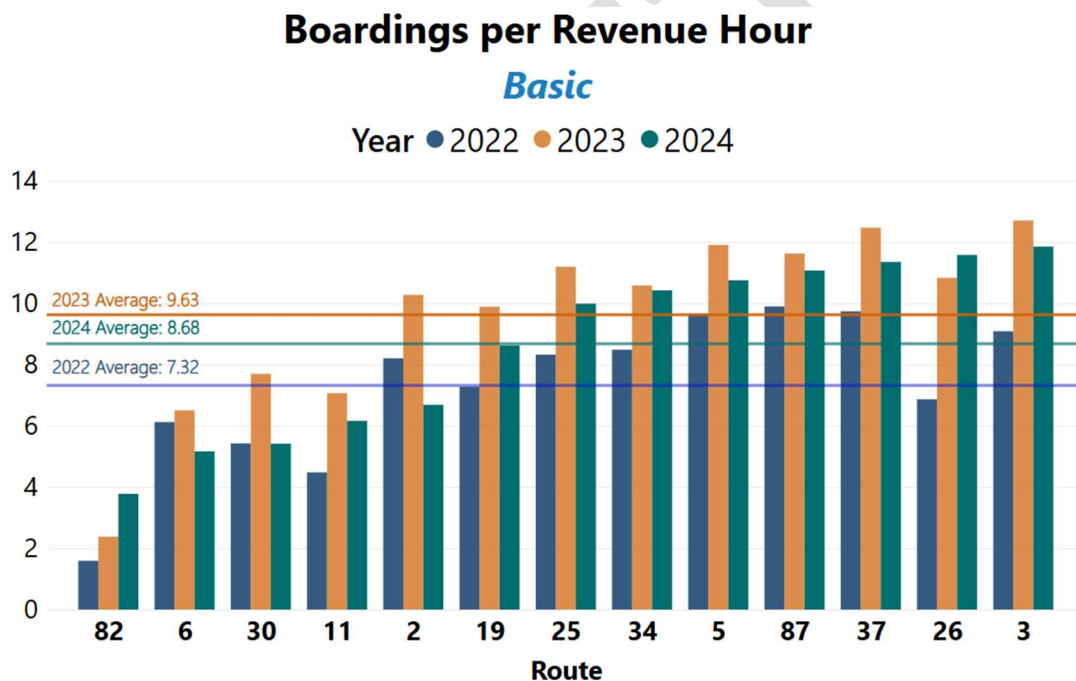
The routes with a frequency of 15-20mins are categorized as “Frequent” routes. The Average boardings per revenue hour decreased by 1.83 (10.7 %) in 2024 vs 2023. Route 8 remains the highest performing, followed by Route 39 (replaced by Purple Line starting October 2024) and Route 10. The decrease from 2024 to 2023 can be attributed to the frequency changes and detours. Issues with Route level reporting in the MyKey data in quarter 4 also contributed to the lower boarding figures for several routes.

Basic

Routes with 30 mins frequency are categorized as “Basic”. The Average boardings per revenue hour decreased by 9.9% in 2024 vs 2023. The performance of most routes in 2024 remains relatively consistent, with a slight decrease primarily due to route modifications and frequency adjustments. Issues with Route level reporting in the MyKey data in quarter 4 also contributed to the lower boarding figures for several routes.

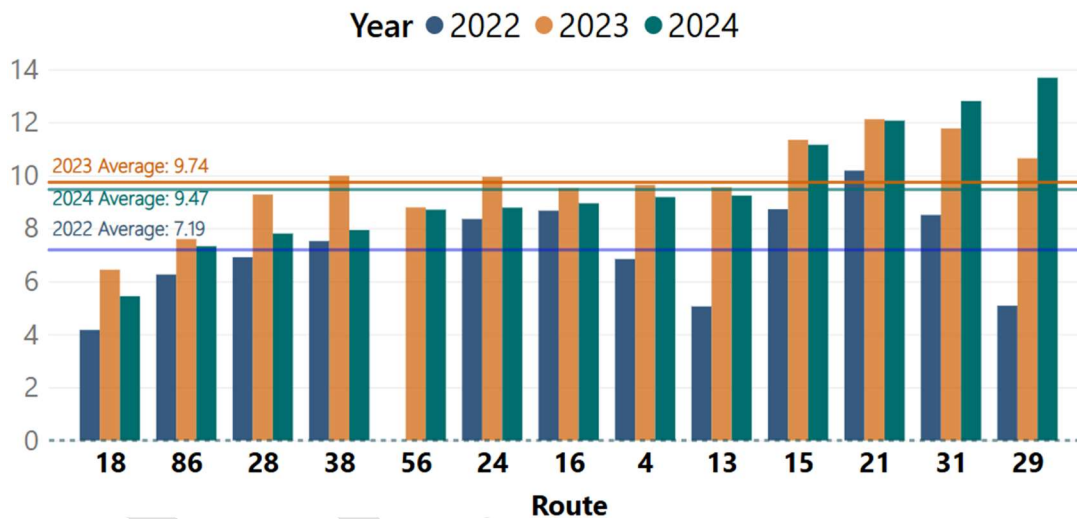

Coverage

Routes with 60 mins frequency are categorized as “Coverage”. The Average boardings per revenue hour decreased by 0.27(2.8%) in 2024 vs 2023. Most routes continue to show stronger performance in 2024 and the slight decrease in performance can be attributed to route changes. Issues with Route level reporting in the MyKey data in quarter 4 also contributed to the lower boarding figures for several routes.

Coverage



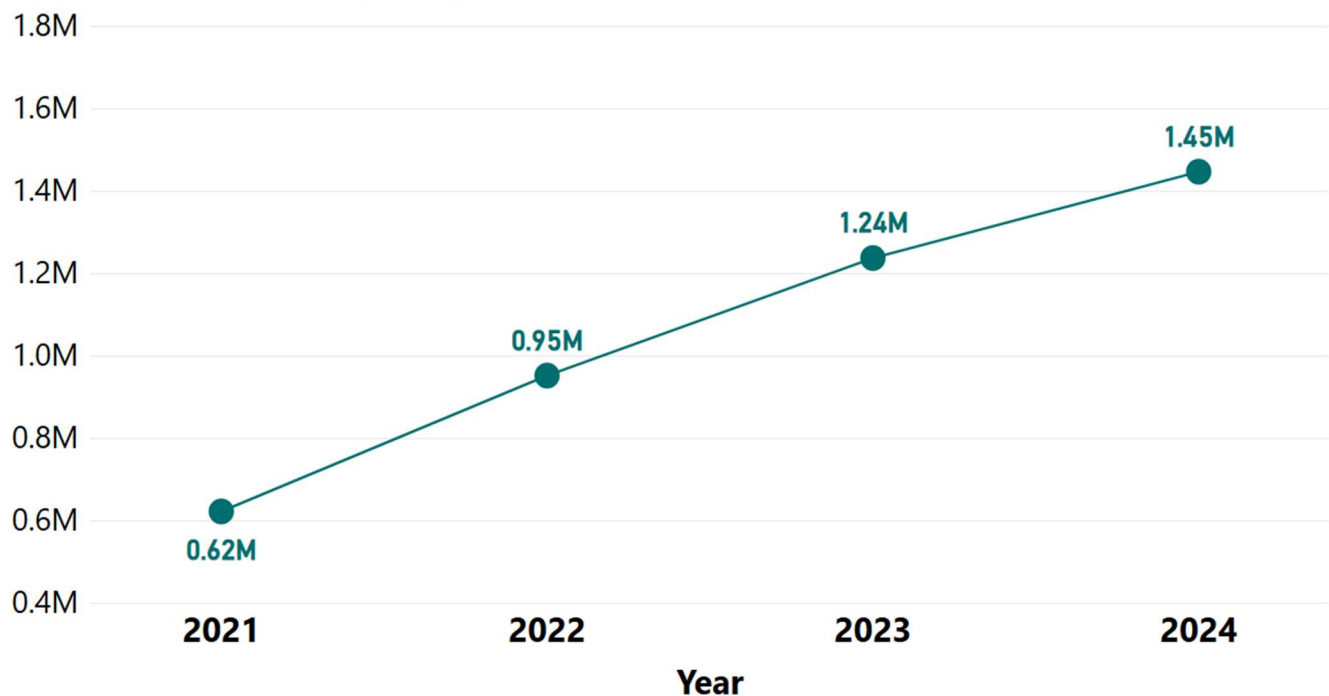

MyKey Validations

A MyKey Validation refers to a transaction by the rider using MyKey. These validations include transactions on both BRT platforms and buses. The number of transactions shows a steady increase over the years. The total validations increased by 209,559 (16.4%) in 2024 vs 2023.

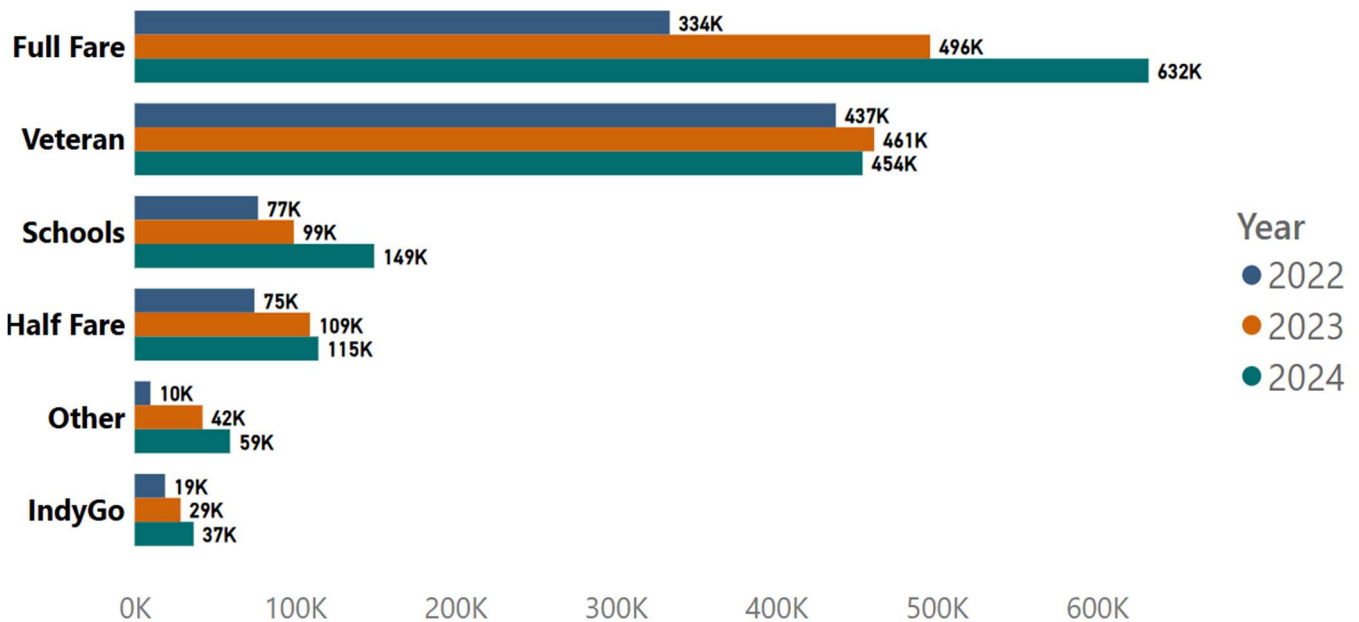
MyKey Validations over Years



Category Level

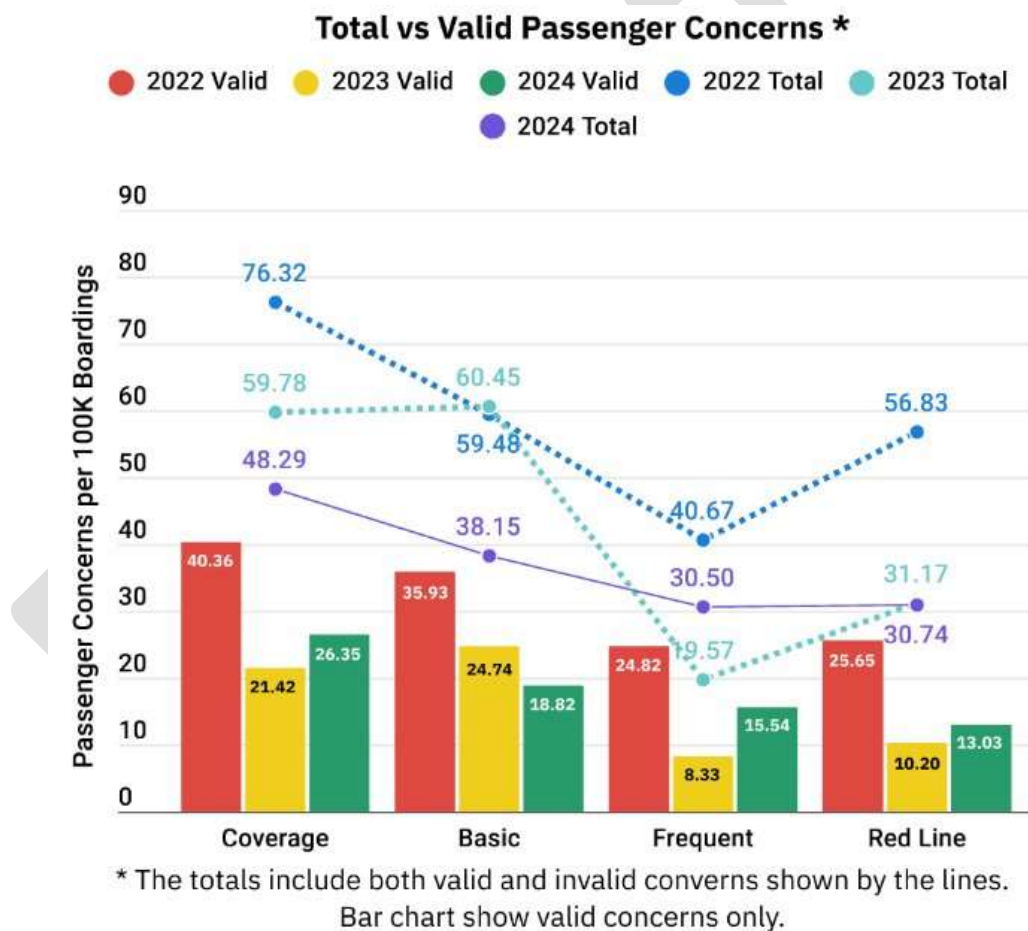
The number of transactions in the Full Fare category saw the largest absolute increase in validation with an increase of 136K in 2024 vs 2023. Whereas the Veteran category has been relatively stable with a slight dip in 2024 with 1.5% decrease in 2024 vs 2023. The Schools category showed a strong growth trend with almost double the validations from 2022 to 2024. An increase of 50.5% in 2024 vs 2023. The Half Fare, IndyGo and Other categories also displayed an increase over the years.

MyKey Validations by Category



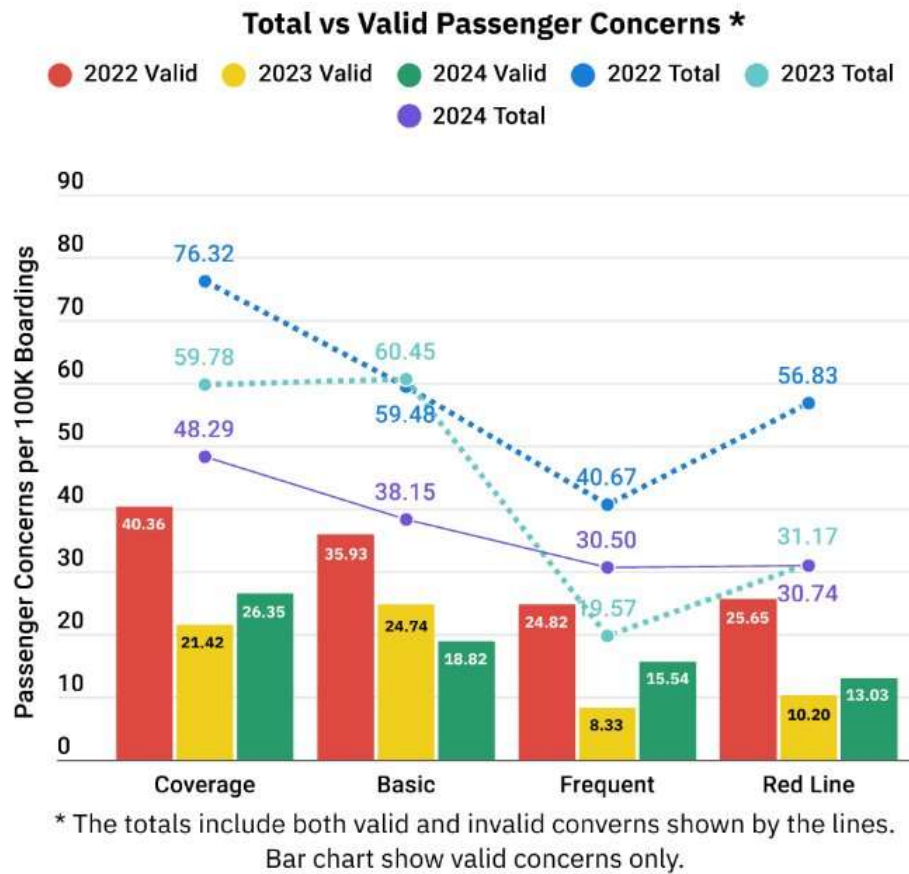
Customer Concerns

The 2024 data reveal key insights into passenger feedback trends across different service types. Basic service saw a notable decline in valid concerns, dropping from 24.75 per 100K boardings in 2023 to 18.82 in 2024. Similarly, total concerns (valid and invalid combined) decreased significantly from 60.46 in 2023 to 38.15 in 2024, suggesting improvements in service quality and passenger satisfaction.



In contrast, the Coverage service experienced an increase in valid concerns, rising from 21.42 in 2023 to 26.35 in 2024, despite a decrease in total concerns from 59.79 to 48.30.

The Frequent service showed an increase in valid concerns, rising from 8.33 per 100K boardings in 2023 to 15.55 in 2024. While the rise in valid concerns suggests that more issues are being identified, the increase in total concerns highlights a greater volume of feedback, both reasonable and unreasonable. This signals an opportunity to focus on resolving the actual service issues to improve overall passenger satisfaction.



The Red Line saw an increase in valid concerns, with Rapid 90 rising to 13.03 highlighting areas where service improvements are needed.

Overall, the data indicates that valid concerns across most service types are on the decline, reflecting improvements in service performance and a better passenger experience, although the Coverage service remains an area for further attention. The rise in total comments, particularly for Coverage and Frequent services, may suggest that riders are increasingly engaged in providing feedback, which could help pinpoint areas for further improvement.

Risk and Safety

All Modes of Service (Fixed, BRT and Paratransit)

There was a 17-percentage point drop in achieving the overall FY2024 Safety Goal compared to 2023, with 33% of the target met in 2024 versus 50% in the previous year.

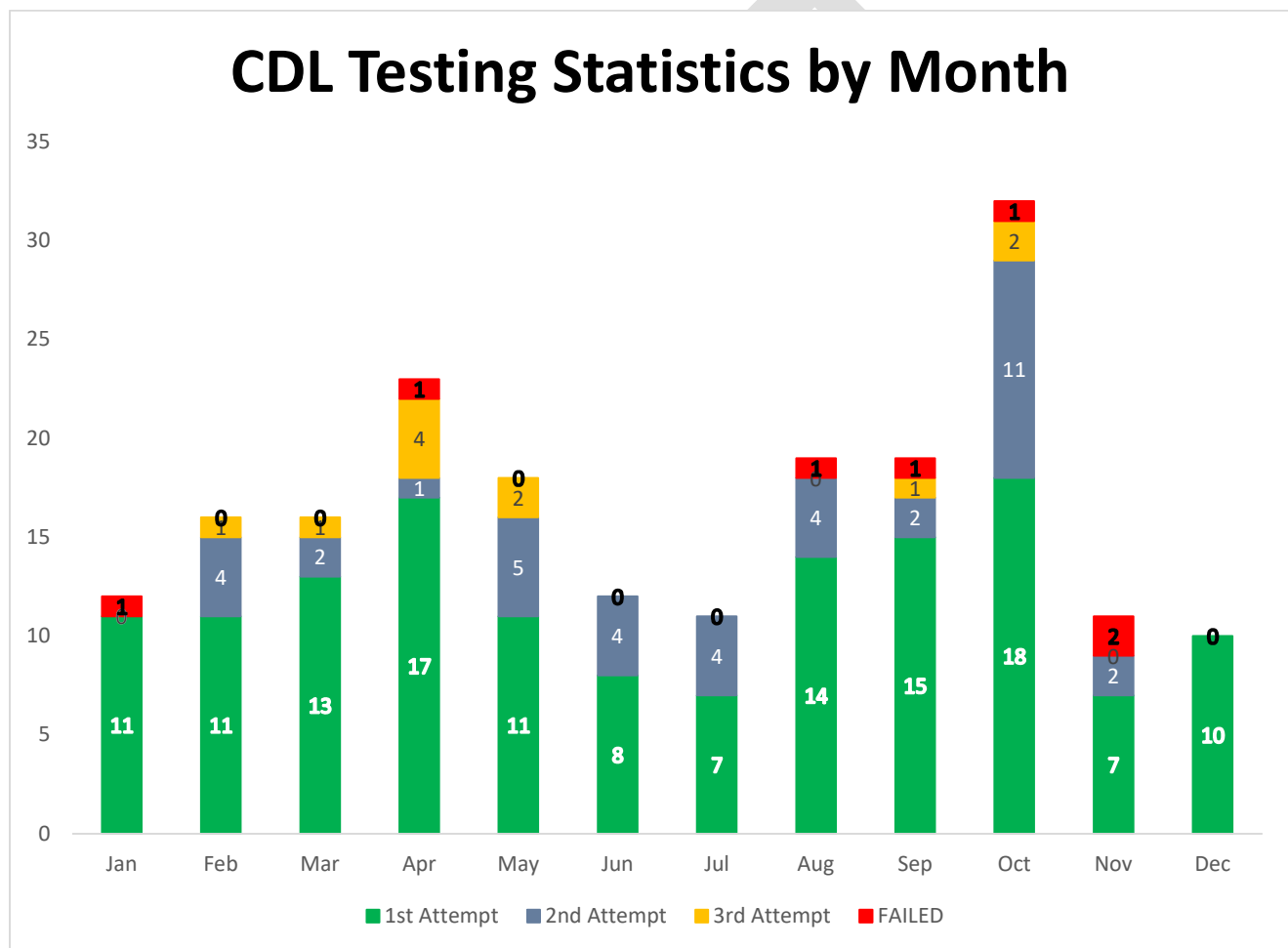


Ride Checks & Arrests

This graph displays the number of students that were scheduled for a CDL State Test and if they passed it on the first, second or third attempt or if they failed the test. Each operator was given the opportunity to pass the test three times before being considered a failed test.



Glossary

Arrest Graph – This graph displays the number of arrests made by a Nolan Law Enforcement Office. The arrest can happen on the bus, bus stop, shelter, or at the CTC. The arrest can be anything from a warrant, disturbance or other illegal or criminal activity.

Average Weekday Boardings – The average number of persons who board the transit system on a day that normal weekday revenue service is provided.

Boardings Per Revenue Hour – This is a productivity measure comparing the number of boardings to the number of revenue hours operated. It measures service utilization per unit of service operated. The revenue hours are the time when a vehicle is available to the general public to carry passengers. This will include layover but exclude deadheads.

BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) Routes – The BRT route is a multi-component transit improvement that includes preferential treatment at traffic signals and dedicated bus lanes to improve bus operating speed and on-time performance.

CDL Testing Graph – This graph displays the number of students that were scheduled for a CDL State Test and if they passed it on the first, second or third attempt or if they failed the test. Each operator was given the opportunity to pass the test three times before being considered a failed test.

Deadhead – Time during movement of a transit vehicle without passengers aboard, typically from the operating division to the start of the route.

Invalid Concern - A concern that, after investigation, is found to be untrue or lacking sufficient basis.

Layover – Break the driver/vehicle is given at the end of a trip before beginning its next trip.

On-Time Performance – A reliability measure capturing the percentage of transit vehicles departing or arriving at a location on time. On-time performance is measured only for specific locations called timepoints for which a schedule is published. A bus transit vehicle is considered “on time” if it departs a location within three minutes before and five minutes after its published scheduled time. At the last timepoint location of a trip, early arrival is considered on-time.

Passenger Concerns Per 100,000 Boardings – A customer service measure that captures the number of passenger complaint/concerns per 100,000 boardings. This measure reports the amount of customer complaints received on the service that is attributed to an operating division of the agency.

Percent Scheduled Service Operated – This service reliability measure indicates the percent of service hours completed based on published schedule. A service is considered not completed when scheduled service hours are lost due to equipment failure, missed or late pull-outs, accidents/incidents, or natural causes.

Preventable Accidents – A preventable accident is defined as accidents in which the transit driver is normally deemed responsible or partly responsible for the occurrence of the accident.

Purchased Transportation – Contract services that fulfil fixed route duties on behalf of IndyGo.

Security Ride Checks Graph – This graph displays the number of rides that the Nolan LEO completes on a bus. A ride check is where the LEO will board the bus and ride out with the operator to any stop and will exit the bus. They will then board a bus going in the other direction and ride it to another stop.

Revenue Hours – Time when a vehicle is available to the general public to carry passengers. This will include layover but exclude deadhead. (First pick up to last drop off)

Total Boardings – The total number of boardings using IPTC directly operated bus service. Riders are counted each time they board a bus.

Total Comments - Valid Comments + Invalid Comments

Valid Concern - A concern that, after undergoing the investigation process, is determined to be true or reasonable.
