Key Features and Considerations




Shared Governance on Campus is Critical to Decision-making

Faculty Engagement and Consultation

- Formal and informal
- Systemwide consultation: council, committee, and ad hoc group representation
- Labor-management engagement through formal processes, such as meet and confer
- Informal engagement: regular meetings with ASA leadership, primarily the senior vice chancellor and associate vice chancellor for academic affairs

ASA Shared Governance Communication Model
