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
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



Microsoft Copilot Evaluation Program

- » About the Program
 - Provide training
 - Evaluate Copilot capabilities
 - Identify value and ROI



Admin Tasks Team: Key Contributions

Enhances Program & Curriculum Development:

- » Example: Lean Leader Lab & Cybersecurity.
- » Creates project-based activities and assessments.
- » Improves website content for marketing materials.

Streamlines Grant Processes:

- » Idea generation and alignment with values.
- » Drafts and reviews applications for RFPs.
- » Increases submissions and sponsorship leads.

Efficiency and Process Improvements

Admin Task Streamlining:

- » Manages notes, task lists, and presentations.
- » Builds forms using Microsoft Forms.
- » Internally de-identifies resumes for job applicants.

Daily Efficiency Gains:

- » Enhances file searching and email management.
- » Improves grammatical accuracy in communications.
- » Boosts responsiveness to stakeholders.



Instructional Design and Assessment

Options for team members to evaluate:

- 1. Assignment Design
- 2. UDL Review (Universal Design for Learning)
- 3. Student Feedback processes

Assignment Design example:

Nursing Department – Service Learning Reflection paper

Nursing – Service Learning Reflection

Instructor Process:

- 1. Uploaded relevant curriculum documents to Copilot
- 2. Wrote a basic prompt for output needs

MS Copilot created:

- 1. Assignment description and outline
- 2. Alignment of assignment to course outcomes

Time Spent: Copilot vs. No Copilot (in minutes) 10 60

Copilot Chat Assistant for minnstate.edu

- » Pilot conducted by system office ITS and Marketing and Communications staff
- » Low-cost alternative for current 3rd party vendor product
- » Already provides more relevant information for prospective students than current 3rd party chatbot
- » Responses based on Minnesota State's knowledge base(s),
 Microsoft Bing, and generative AI
- » Team reviewing responses for relevance, accuracy, ethical concerns, and unexpected uses

Copilot Chat Assistant: Three Variations

The system office is piloting three variations of the Copilot Chat Assistant for use on the minnstate.edu website.

- » <u>Version 1</u>: Uses generative AI and a single knowledge base
- » <u>Version 2</u>: Uses generative AI and multiple knowledge bases
- » <u>Version 3</u>: Uses static prompts and multiple knowledge bases
