#### Part 1. Policy Statement.

- 4 It is the policy of tThe Board of Trustees shall to-provide financial statement information
- 5 that is accurate, timely, reliable, and consistent. Information provided to the state as part
- 6 of the state-wide financial audit will be of high quality and consistent with standards of
- 7 excellence. The chancellor and presidents will be dedicated to continuous improvement
- 8 of financial reporting.
- 9 It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to The board shall seek audited financial
- statements for Minnesota State Colleges and Universities the system as a whole, the
- 11 Rrevenue Ffund, and individual colleges and universities institutions as designated by
- 12 Bboard action. Additionally, individual activity financial statements may be required
- 13 through bond covenants and other statutory requirements. To that end, the board Board
- 14 of Trustees has adopted a multi-year audit plan. The chancellor shall periodically advise
- the **B**board of progress toward the **B**board's audit plan.

- 17 All financial reports must shall—be prepared in accordance with the provisions of
- 18 Minnesota Statutes of Minnesota Management and Budget,
- and in conformity with the guidelines of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board
- 20 (GASB), and the guidelines of the National Association of College and University Business
- 21 Officers (NACUBO). The colleges, -and-universities, and system office must provide
- accurate, timely, reliable, and consistent financial information necessary for the prudent
- 23 stewardship of the colleges, and universities, and system office and for systemwide
- 24 reporting. The reports must shall be approved by the Vice Chancellor for Finance and
- 25 Facilities-vice chancellor chief financial officerV.
- 26 The annual Minnesota State Colleges and Universities financial report must shall be
- 27 prepared under the direction of the vice chancellor chief financial officer Vice Chancellor
- 28 <u>for Finance and Facilities</u> and filed with Minnesota Management and Budget as specified
- 29 by law and governmental accounting standards.

- 31 Financial statements will be presented annually to the **Bb**oard of Trustees for its for
