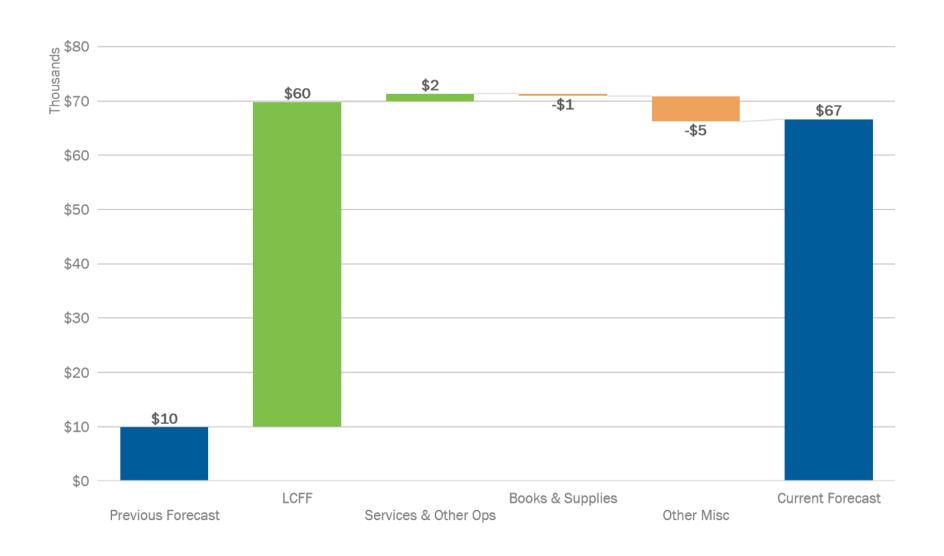

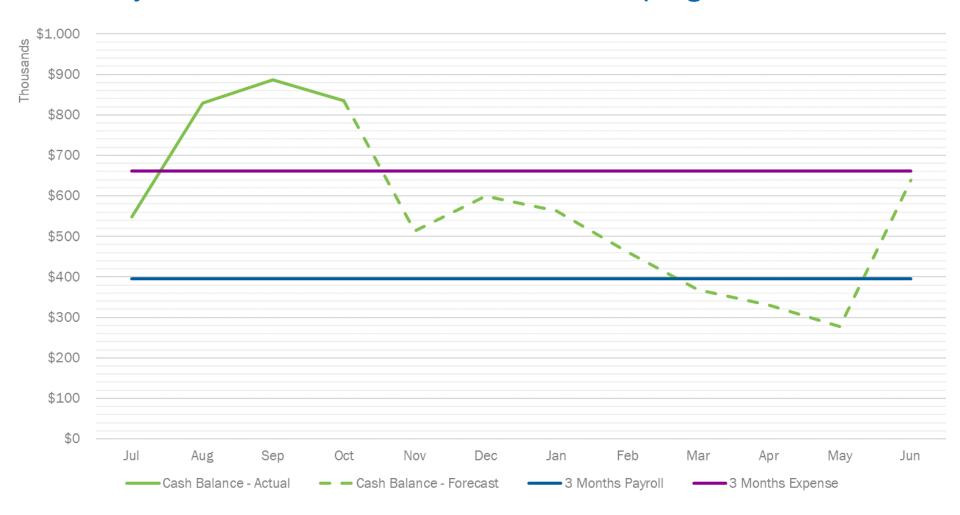

Payback of receivable sales in the fall reduces spring balance



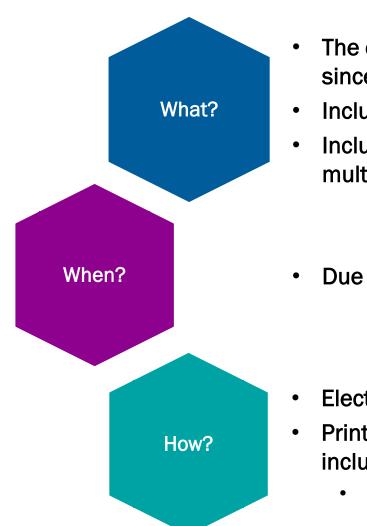
