## **RESOLUTION 20-20**

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXCEPTION TO COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND/OR PRICING QUOTES FOR THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL TO PURCHASE **VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the City Code of Ordinances (CCO) Title 4 – Revenue and Finance, Chapter 4.15 – Purchasing, Section 4.15.030(a) requires a competitive bid process for purchases over \$50,000, but the City Council, by resolution, may waive bid requirements for purchases costing more than \$50,000, but less than \$150,000, subject to CCO 4.15.040; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4.15.040 allows for exceptions to the competitive bid process for contracts for equipment maintenance and repair; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, State Equipment Fleet ("SEF") maintains contracts with vehicle vendors in Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, the City, as a political subdivision of the State of Alaska, is authorized to purchase vehicles on the SEF contract; and,

WHEREAS, the SEF contract is currently with two vendors in Alaska, Alaska Sales and Service and Kendal Ford; and,

WHEREAS, Kendall is a Ford dealer and Alaska Sales and Service is a Chevy dealer; and,

WHEREAS, after comparing prices of half-ton pickup trucks made by Ford and Chevy, City employees determined the Chevy vehicles to be generally less expensive than comparable Ford vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to purchase up to three new vehicles in 2021 that would cost between \$50,000 and \$150,000 combined; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and the public to use public funds conservatively and seek the best value; and.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Council of the City of Saint Paul, Alaska:

Section 1: Approves the purchase of up to three new vehicles for the City in accordance with the approved CY2021 budget; and,

Section 2: By authorizing this resolution waives the competitive bidding process for each of the individual vehicle purchases; and,

Section 3: Authorizes the City Manager to purchase the new vehicles from Alaska Sales and Service for the City in accordance with the approved CY2021 budget.
