

MINUTES
EMERGENCY CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 7, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jacob Mercurief at 2:09 PM. Councilmembers present were Daniel Porath, Jason Bourdukofsky, Naomi Edenshaw, Joseph Kozloff, Victor Clarey and Raymond Melovidov. A quorum was established. This meeting was aired on KUHB.

CALL TO ORDER

Clmbr Bourdukofsky moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Clmbr Edenshaw. Motion carried by voice vote.

AGENDA
APPROVED

Clmbr Porath moved to approve Emergency Ordinance 22-96, A Proclamation of Emergency “Hunker Down” Order to Prevent Further Spread of COVID-19 Throughout Saint Paul Island, seconded by Clmbr Bourdukofsky. Covid-19 is spreading throughout the community. This Emergency Ordinance is for 10 days, everyone should remain home as much as possible. Essential businesses should remain open and provide services. A well fitted mask will be required when indoors and around others. This would also extend Emergency Ordinance 22-95 until this ordinance expires. As of today, there are about 56 new cases. This is just over a week timeframe. Out of the 56 cases 52 people have exhibited symptoms, 4 people have remained asymptomatic. The essential worker that started exhibiting symptoms and tested positive had been on island for 17 days. He tested negative prior to traveling to Saint Paul and again at day 5. From there it spread through the housekeeping staff, kitchen staff and then the TDX workers.

Clmbr Clarey asked what the CDC guidelines are for testing positive then getting out of isolation. He is wondering if 10 days is too long.

Manager Zavakil stated that the CDC says isolate for 5 days and wear a well fitted mask around others for 5 days after that. It is estimated that 60% of the spread is through asymptomatic individuals.

Clmbr Clarey made a motion to amend the Emergency Ordinance Hunker Down to 7 days rather than 10 days, seconded by Clmbr Kozloff.
