Mgr Zavadil gave his report: COVID-19 continues to be the main-focus. Working on travel forms and ensuring tests are received. Ravn plans to operate in Alaska and hire back as many employees as they can. Mgr Zavadil will get into contact with FLOAT to get more information on their plans to fly to St. Paul. The new provider at the Health Center is an essential worker and will see customer owners during his quarantine period. He will wear all the PPE when seeing customer owners. He will not be in the same workspace as the other Health Center employees. All essential workers need to have a Community Protection Plan in place and are only allowed to go to work and home. They will not be allowed in any public buildings. The City of Saint Paul cannot say what is essential and what is not. This is up to the entity to determine if the project is essential at this time. This is set by the State mandate.

Section 2-Travel will add: all individuals traveling to Saint Paul Island must complete and submit to the City the attached COVID-19 Travel Form within 24-48 hours of travel to document that they have a plan in place, developed with the City, for safe return and quarantine. Due to the change the Ordinance will be renumbered to Emergency Ordinance 20-95.
