Section 4.e: Individuals on quarantine can obtain gas but must remain in their vehicle. Section 13-Penalties: Public Safety is authorized to enforce individual compliance with the ordinance. They will first educate the individuals. In the event this does not result in voluntary compliance, Public Safety is authorized to: issue a warning, issues a citation to Tribal Court, issues a citation for a level III offense that would result in fines increasing in increments of \$50.00 up to the maximum of \$300.00. The City will need to work on Section 9 of City Code of Ordinances to add an administrative process for collection, appeals and tracking of fines issued.
