ORDINANCE 24-01

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL REVISING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLE 4 – REVENUE AND FINANCE, CHAPTER 4.25 - SALES TAX, 4.25.040 – EXEMPTIONS FROM SALES TAX - GENERALLY, SUBSECTION (E)

Section 1. Classification. This a non-coded ordinance that amends existing provisions of the City’s Code of Ordinances. Section 2 of this ordinance shall become a permanent part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Saint Paul.

Section 2. Amendment. Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, Alaska, that the City Code of Ordinances shall be revised and amended by removing Title 4 – Revenue and Finance, Chapter 4.25 - Sales Tax, 4.25.040 – Exemptions form sales tax - Generally, Subsection (e) Sales of seafood on vessels 46 feet or less length overall (LOA) as set forth in the following attachment.

Section 3. Severability. As provided in the City Code of Ordinances Chapter 1.05, Section 1.05.070 Severability, if any portion of this ordinance is subsequently found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

Section 4. Duration. This ordinance shall remain in effect until revised by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter 1.05, Section 1.05.080, Amendments to the Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately following its adoption by the City Council.
