Based on the available record, the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) for Title V (P.L. 93-638) projects has made the following determination on the proposed activity/action/undertaking. No negative impacts were identified that may occur as a result of the project. As a result of the findings related to this environmental review, an Environmental Review Checklist is not needed for the proposed action. The Categorical Exclusion<sup>1</sup> applicable to this activity/action/undertaking is marked below.

NHPA Compliance Requirements: A review of the effects of the project on historic properties has been conducted in order to meet compliance requirements for the use of public funding under 54 USC 306108. NEPA Determination: The burn unit installation is restricted to the foot print of the existing land fill and has no potential to affect cultural resources in the vicinity of the APE.
