



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- Lynn sent an email to the ACSPI grant writing team
- Introduced herself, mentioned working recently with Charlene on a DOJ CTAS grant proposal
- Commented on the busy time in the grant world now, with all the infrastructure funding
- Expressed concern of unknowingly developing proposals that compete with one another, overlap in scope, or draw upon the same resources
- Expressed concerned that some projects require the involvement of, or commitment from, each other's organizations that isn't being discussed first
- Discussed how we often request letters of support from each other's leaders.
- Expressed desire to work together more and the importance of the City and the Tribal Government having synergy with projects and proposals.
- Proposed a regular monthly meeting to discuss what we're working on, with the goal of improving our alignment, communication, and collaboration.
