RESOLUTION 22-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR CITY OF SAINT PAUL EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED IN CY2023

WHEREAS, Policy 3.11, Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) requires the City Council to approve a Cost of Living Adjustment; and,

WHEREAS, Policy 3.11 states: Except for contracted employees, cost of living increases may be approved by the City Council and cost of living pay increase or decreases shall not exceed seven percent (7%) per calendar year; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal COLA for CY2023 is expected to be approximately 8.7%; and,

WHEREAS, the City is facing a large budget deficit in CY2023 due to no crab season; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council that all employees receive a COLA for CY2023 in the amount of 6.0%; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council recommends to the City Manager that employment agreements for contracted employees be amended to reflect this COLA; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the City of Saint Paul by this resolution hereby approves a 6.0% Cost of Living Adjustment for each employee that was employed with the City of Saint Paul as of January 1, 2023.
