



EMS REPORT

Reporting Period: 09/01/2023 – 10/15/2023

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CALL VOLUME

- 09/01/23 – 10/15/23:
 - 72 public safety (VPSO/Fire/EMS) actions documented in EFORCE
 - 38 actions were direct requests for service (911 call or nonemergency line)
 - 20 of 38 requests involved EMS dispatch (53%)
 - High percentage of non-transport, refusal, or no patient found (non-collectible) calls.

EDUCATION

- Offering **AHA – Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider**, **AHA – Heartsaver CPR/AED** and **AHA – Heartsaver First Aid CPR/AED** courses out of EMS Room on backside of Saint Paul Health Clinic between 9 AM – 5 PM on a rolling basis – students can schedule at their choosing, max course size 3 students (<https://calendly.com/saintpaulislandems>). Pricing TBD. Note cancellation policy with respect to 911 calls, medevacs, etc.
- Aiden Panzer obtained his Nationally Registered EMT-Basic certification in Oregon, intends on volunteering on Saint Paul Island next summer.
- More education tools being developed for EMS courses.

EQUIPMENT

- **\$2500 grant** received from American Seafoods; funds to be put towards purchase of various basic items (on-board inverter to supply power to ambulance wall outlets, etc.)

OTHER

- **Island-Wide Public Safety Navigation Map**
 - Fire hydrant locations added; will be distributed at next Fire training.

OPERATIONAL GOALS:

- **EMS POCUS (Point-of-Care Ultrasound)** – Need funding for unit (G.E. VSCAN Air) and appropriate training and associated protocols to implement.
