COVID-19

Vaccine

As of March 5, 2021, 141 residents are fully vaccinated with the Moderna vaccine and 42 have received their first dose.

A SCF provider is hand carrying 300 doses of the Moderna vaccine this week. Trident plans to vaccinate 142 of their employees at the plant using their providers.

Saint Paul Island Unified Command

The Saint Paul Island Unified Command met on February 15 and March 1, 2021 to review and provide input into the *attached St. Paul Island Tour COVID Plan*. Additionally, the Unified Command reviewed and commented on proposed City Emergency Ordinance 21-92. The structure of the Unified Command was reorganized into functional groups (*see attached SPIUC Organization Chart*). The Planning and Policy Group for the Unified Command will meet a couple times in March to review community risk indicators and the strategic reentry plan and recommend changes to these documents.

MEETING WITH TDX CEO CHRIS MANDREGAN

On February 8, 2021 I had a Zoom meeting with TDX CEO Chris Mandregan and TDX CAO Tina Woods. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss how the City and TDX could improve communication and collaboration. We discussed working together on: Harbor improvements and expansion; Power plant, electrical distribution and wind farm upgrades and further integrations; Road maintenance; Fuel farms maintenance. The plan is to set up more regular meeting to discuss these items.

ATAOAN AKUN EXECUTIVE PLANNING COMMITTEE

On February 25, 2021, the Aleut Community of Saint Paul Island (ACSPI), Central Bering Sea Fishermen's Association (CBSFA), City of Saint Paul (City), and TDX Corporation (TDX) met via Zoom to discuss reforming the Ataqan Akun Executive Planning Committee (AAEPC). Amos Philemonoff and Patrick Baker were in attendance for ACSPI, Phillip Lestenkof was in attendance for CBSFA, I was



in attendance for the City, and Chris Mandregan was in attendance for TDX. We discussed changed to the *attached AAEPC MOU* and projects that we may want to focus on jointly. The MOU is currently under review and we are setting a deadline date of when the MOU could be approved by the board/council of each participating entity.

SAINT PAUL HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS/EXPANSION FEAIBILITY STUDY
