RE: Resolution 23-08 - A Resolution of the Council of the City of Saint Paul for the Appointment of a New Council Member

SUMMARY: A council seat became vacant in March and needed to be filled.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: During the scheduled April City Council meeting, the Council gave direction to the City Clerk to advertise for letters of interest for the purpose of appointment.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION: In March, Councilman Clarey resigned from his seat, leaving a seat vacant. The council was given information according to Ordinance 2.15.250 on them having the authority to appoint a qualified individual to fill the vacant Council seat for the remainder of the term. Two options were available, through appointment of special election. The council chose to appoint versus holding a special election. A call for letters of interest was advertised.
