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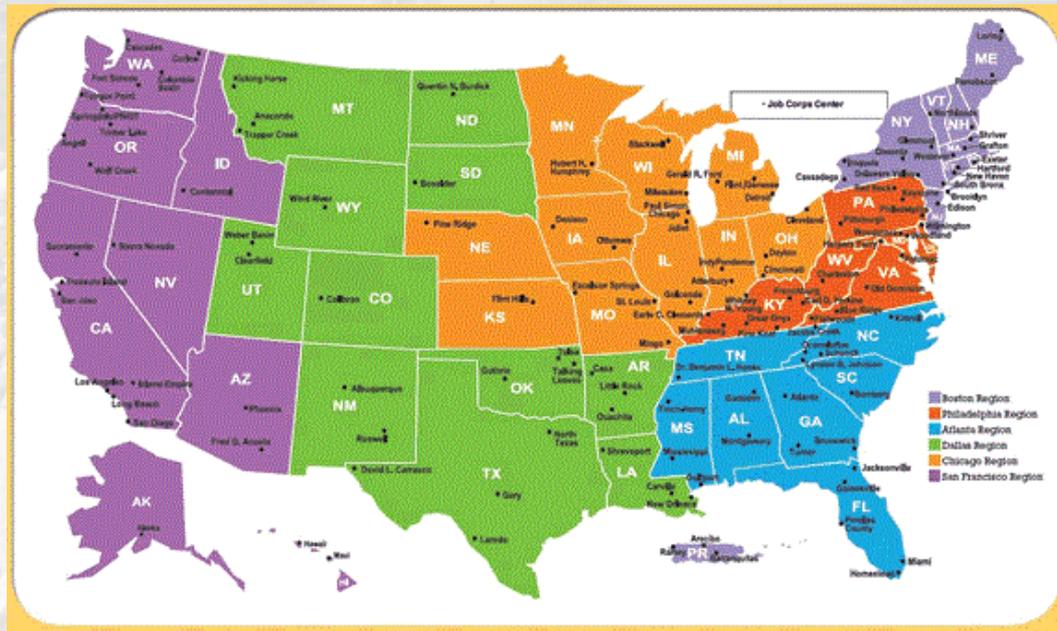
Job Corps Mission Statement

Job Corps is the nations' largest residential employment and training program that helps young people learn a career, earn a high school diploma or equivalency, and find and keep a good job/career.

For eligible young people at least 16 to 24 years of age that qualify as low income, Job Corps provides the all-around skills needed to succeed in a career and in life.

Job Corps History

- Began during President Lyndon B. Johnson's administration as part of the War on Poverty
- Program began in 1964 (60 years ago) and serves about 33,000 students each year
- Over 120 Job Corps Centers (and at least one Job Corps center in each state & Puerto Rico)

Wind River Job Corps Center

- Opened its doors in 2015
- The newest center specifically built to be a Job Corps Center
- The only Job Corps Center in Wyoming
- Primarily serves students from, Texas (40%), Colorado (40%), & Wyoming/Montana (20%)



Academics & Technical Training

- The purpose of Job Corps is technical training that leads to related employment. WRJCC offers nine training options (and the opportunity to complete HSD/HSE):
 - Building Construction Technology
 - Carpentry
 - Electrical
 - Heavy Construction Equipment Mechanic
 - Heavy Equipment Operator
 - Heavy Truck Driving
 - Medical
 - Petroleum Service Technician
 - Welding

Direct Center Performance Metrics

- 90-Day Retention Rate (80%)

- Career Technical Training (CTT) Completion (75%)
