- Unemployed
- Low Income (below 125% of the Federal Poverty Level)

Priority of Service: Qualified Veterans and spouses

Over 65

Disability

Low Literacy Skills

Limited English Proficiency

Reside in a Rural Area

Homeless or at Risk of Homelessness

Low Employment Prospects

Failed to Find Employment after WIOA Title



Community Service Assignment

- Part time
- Federal minimum wage
- Placed at a non-profit or public organization
- Individual durational limit of 48 months



Benefit to Participants

- Gain workplace skills leading to unsubsidized employment
- Networking/building relationships with employers
- Socialization
- Referrals to other organizations and co-enrollment with other workforce programs
- Extra income



Benefit to Employers

- Gain additional temporary help
- Seniors can bring a lot of previous experience
- Can hire participants from the program



Department of Workforce Services

- Operates 43 SCSEP positions in the following counties:
 - Natrona
 - Converse
 - Hot Springs
 - Fremont
 - Washakie

The remaining counties fall under AARP, which operates as the sub-recipient. Natrona is the exception, where DWS and AARP both have positions.
