#### Transform the Student Experience

- **Equivalency of Transfer Task Force** has been charged and held their first meeting during the month of November. The Task Force is made up of student service and academic leaders from CCD, MSU-Denver, and CU-Denver to review the transfer of courses between the institutions and recommend an action plan for minimizing barriers for students, including but not limited to, the academic curriculum aligned work needed to resolve course equivalency deficits, as applicable.
- **Auraria Hunger and Homelessness Awareness** From November 14 to 16 the Auraria Campus institutions held its 8<sup>th</sup> annual community event which included community education, resource connections, food pantry resources, free cooking classes, Lunette Cup giveaways, and Share Meals App sign-ups.
- **Share Meals App Launched** Through a tri-institutional effort led by the Auraria Sustainable Campus Program, CCD participated in the launch of the Share Meals App. Share Meals is an app and website that connects event organizers with leftover food to hungry students. This initiative not only feeds our community members, but it helps reduce food waste from our many campus events.

How it works is event organizers who have leftover food from an event make a posting to the app/website of how many leftovers are available, how long the food is available, and where to go. From there, students who are on campus will receive a notification telling them where they can go to pick up a meal.

#### Transform Our Own Workforce Experience

- **Monthly Match Returns!** CCD's Center for Workforce Initiatives and Human Resources re-launched our Monthly Match. This program helps connect our community by getting to know fellow staff and faculty members better.

- **Helping Employees with Student Loan Debt** On October 13, 2022, CCD hosted a student loan debt clinic to learn more about the Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) federal program and how to take advantage of an important federal waiver that expired on October 31, 2022.
