The Board determines policies for the System, including its Community Colleges. The Chancellor adopts procedures as necessary to implement Board policies.

The following System Procedures (SPs) have been adopted, revised, or repealed as part of our five-year review cycle and/or to conform with new or updated laws:

- SP 19-10a, Firearms and Weapons on Campus (*Revised, Retitled* from Bulling/Violence/Firearms on Campus, and *Renumbered* from SP 19-10)
  - Five-year review
  - Updated with new legislative requirements
  - Splitting SP into two, creating stand-alone SP for weapons and firearms
- SP 19-10b, Bullying and Violence (*New*)
  - Created stand-alone SP with bulling and violence sections of SP 19-10
- SP 3-60b, Employee Leave (*Revised*)
  - Updated with new legislative requirements
