Northeastern Baseball has made national news five times recently.

 Current NJC freshman right-handed pitcher Ondrej Vank, just returned from playing for the Czech Republic in Taiwan and Japan for 10 days helping prepare for the Premier 12, which is the top amateur baseball players in the world representing their countries. (This is the world baseball classic, but players from MLB are not eligible to play).



- NJC baseball alum and graduate Amar Mahmood represented and helped Pakistan win the first ever Baseball United Arab Classic Championship in Dubai.
- NJC baseball alum and graduate Josh Cote, who is currently playing
 Division I baseball at Toledo this fall, was honored for his tremendous
 spring of 2024 season at NJC (where he broke the NJC single season and
 career home run records, as well as RBI record), and was named to the
 Canadian Baseball Network's ALL CANADA TEAM.
- NJC Assistant Baseball Coach Bill Percy was awarded the Lefty Gomez award at the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame banquet as he continues his Hall of Fame Career!
- Finally, a data and sports statistics company on social media that covers college baseball called "TheBaseballCube" recognized NJC and our relationship we have created with Armcare.com. This last spring NJC pitchers (for the first time in program history), finished ranked fifth in the entire country in strikeouts per game. Armcare.com has also taken to social media to promote how their product has helped NJC pitchers in this success and has helped put NJC Baseball on the map in terms of the best pitching program in the world is now promoting our program to their millions of followers on social media and their website.
