 - #4 for National Scholarships (TAMU, Embry-Riddle, VaTech)
 - #3 for unit size nationally; among SMCs (TAMU & VaTech)
 - #2 for Navy Production (behind TAMU)
 - #1 for Marine-option production
 - #1 Sideloads Scholarships, Adv Standing (USN & USMC)
