S1/S2 Fall Updates

S1 (Personnel) Update

- Hell Week
 - Aided in coordinating the matriculation of 498 rats
 - Organized/Staff Regimental Operations Center (ROC) = 50 cadets
 - Tracked cadet/company movements
 - 364 to VMI Infirmary
 - 198 to MSA / Field Hospital
 - 57 to New Cadet Retention Center (NCRC)
 - 309 to NCAA team events
- Supported 14 Rat Hell Week out-processing (OP) actions
- AY24-25 Supported Rat OPs: 48 to date

S2 (Academic Affairs) Update

- Academic Time
 - Planned/executed three Rat training sessions during Hell Week
 - Completed four Academic Duty Saturday events in Fall term
 - Organized Monday Dean's Time events
 - Focus areas: study techniques, test taking tips, academic planning, computer training, and general counseling
- Peer Tutoring Program
 - Over 100 requests for tutor support
 - Over 100 cadet tutors available / at least 7 tutors in every academic discipline
 - 172 tutoring sessions logged
 - 207 hours of tutoring recorded

S3 (Operations) Update

- Completed weekly OPORDs for Corps activities
- Coordinated large event execution plans (i.e. Founder's Day)
- Focus Areas: improving flexibility and efficiency in operational planning

S4 (Logistics) Update

- Cadre/Hell Week Support
 - Prepared hay for distribution
 - Assembled miscellaneous and food boxes

 - Staged water for rat workouts and other water-related needs
