## Issues & Challenges:

- **VDOT RT 11 Bike Lane Expansion/KH Parking Issues**
  - Bike lane expansion will reduce roadside parking in front of KH (over 50 spots) from Hook Ln to beyond CPTF.
- **Revise Nuke Power Preparation**
  - VMI faculty engagement has had positive results for NR interview; potential 1-credit PY nuke study course will reinforce this
  - Nuke students will be required to take PY 453 in senior spring (Naval Nuclear Power School preparation)
