Dear Board Members:

The agenda items of Southwestern Oklahoma State University are as follows:

I. PERSONNEL

A. CHANGE IN STATUS

Dr. Leslie Friend has been appointed to the tenure track position as Assistant Professor in the Department of Music in the College of Arts and Sciences at Southwestern Oklahoma State University effective January 7, 2025. Her salary for the nine-month appointment will be \$51,522.00. Her pay increase will take effect August 1, 2025. She will be able to apply for promotion in Fall of 2029, unless approved by the provost to apply at an earlier date. She has been employed by the university since August of 2023.

B. RETIREMENTS

Dr. Kelley Logan, Professor of English, will retire from her position as of June 1, 2025.

II. FACILITES STEWARDSHIP

A. Master Lease Funding for Jerry & Margaret Hodge Pharmacy & Rural Health Center Request

Southwestern Oklahoma State University requests permission to submit a request for up to \$5,000,000 on the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education Master Lease-Real Property, with repayment over 20 years. Funds will be used for the construction

of a new Academic Building that will help increase capacity and enhance the university's pharmacy doctoral program located on the SWOSU campus. The source of funds for repayment will be from an existing sales tax through the City of Weatherford over the next 10 years.

B. Request for Resolution for Reimbursement of Funds

SWOSU also requests approval of this item under the Bond Purchase Program Reimbursement Resolution allowing Southwestern Oklahoma State University to proceed with this project prior to the availability of funds (OSRHE Master Lease Program).

The Board approval of this item will serve as the formal resolution for reimbursement of funds expended on the project approved for the Bond Program. Under federal guidelines, a reimbursement allocation is a designated use of bond proceeds to pay an expenditure which was previously paid from sources other than bond proceeds. According to Internal Revenue Code, Section 1.150-2, certain preliminary original expenditures related to capital projects may be reimbursed from bond proceeds if the Board declares the intent to do so in a formal resolution. This item will serve as the formal resolution for reimbursement of core operating funds expended on purchases approved for the OSRHE Master Lease Purchase Program.
