A. CHANGE IN STATUS

Ms. Angela Keeler Reeves has been appointed to the tenure track position as Assistant Professor in the Department of Creative Media and Visual Arts in the College of Arts and Sciences at Southwestern Oklahoma State University effective August 16, 2024.
