Board of Visitors Resolution 22

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VIRGINIA INSTITUTE OF MARINE SCIENCE FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, the Virginia Institute of Marine Science, educational and general programs constitute those activities that support the delivery of its tripartite mission of research, education, and advisory service to a large constituency within the Commonwealth and globally;

WHEREAS, these activities include state mandated and sponsored research, advisory service to the Commonwealth, instruction, academic support (including library, information technology, communications, marine operations, seawater research laboratory, analytical, and student services), institutional/administrative support, and plant operations;

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2025-26 State appropriation for the Virginia Institute of Marine Science provides \$34 million in general funds support including a 3% raise and 1.5% bonus for faculty and staff and associated fringe benefit adjustments as well as two new research initiatives relevant to forecasting coastal resilience efforts and sustaining a world-class advanced shellfish breeding program; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation is further supplemented by non-general fund revenues estimated at \$36.7 million, the majority of which are due to externally funded grant and contract activities, and approximately \$1 million attributable to tuition revenues.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Visitors of the College of William & Mary in Virginia approves the FY 2025-26 operating budget of the Virginia Institute of Marine Science, as displayed on the attached schedule.
