Readopt with amendment and renumber Bar 500, effective 9/13/18 (Document #12619), as Bar 1200 to read as follows:

CHAPTER Bar [500] 1200 ETHICAL STANDARDS

PART Bar [501] 1201 OBLIGATION TO OBEY AND ETHICAL CONDUCT STANDARDS

Bar [501] 1201.01 Obligation to Obey.

- (a) Licensees shall obey the ethical conduct standards set forth in Bar [501.02] 1201.02.
- (b) Violations of any of the ethical conduct standards shall constitute unprofessional conduct resulting in disciplinary proceedings pursuant to RSA 313-A:22, II (c).

Bar [501]1201.02 Ethical Conduct Standards. A licensee shall:

- (a) Comply with RSA 313-A and the board and the OPLC's administrative rules;
- (b) Submit only truthful and correct information in any application or other document filed with, or statement made to, the board or the OPLC;
- (c) Obey in good faith, and within any time period specified, any disciplinary orders issued by the board, including orders requiring the payment of fees or fines;
 - (d) Deal with colleagues and clients with honesty and integrity;
 - (e) If maintaining a salon, maintain the salon premises in a sanitary and hygienic manner;
- (f) Not perform any service that is outside the scope of practice for the license that [he or she] the person holds;
 - (g) Not misrepresent professional qualifications or credentials;
 - (h) Not aid or abet, directly or indirectly, the practice of any person who is not duly licensed;
 - (i) Not advertise claims that are misleading, untrue, or insupportable by fact;
- (j) Use professional products specifically designed or manufactured for use in [his or her] their licensed profession according to the manufacturer's instructions; and
 - (k) Cooperate with lawful investigation of the [board] **OPLC**.
