1.Describe the purpose of this purchase of goods, services, information technology, construction, or use of space. The services offered by FLVC are an integral part of Florida's education community. FLVC provides critical educational support services utilized by all public postsecondary institutions within the Florida College System (FCS), the State University System (SUS), and K-12 school districts. Key among those services is the centralized, automated library system used by Florida's 40 public colleges and universities, support services for statewide higher education distance learning, automated tools for college planning and online transfer options for students. FLVC's centralized, shared-services model continues to return significant dividends for the state of Florida in the form of greater efficiency, value generation, cost-savings, and optimization of college/university staff, capital and time.

- **2.Describe the competitive solicitation method used or, if none, the exemption relied on for bid waiver.** No competitive solicitation method was used. The College used the bid waiver exemption provided for the library resources in accordance with FLDOE Rule 6A-14.0734 and College Procedure 6AHx2-6.34 for Library books, reference books, periodicals and other library materials and supplies which cites the exception to the requirement to solicit competitive offers. The group licensing process is a service provided by FLVC to the libraries of the state colleges and universities in Florida. The purpose of the group process is to leverage the collective buying power of the institutions to license e-resources with preferred pricing on their behalf.
- 3.Describe business rationale for the purchase and how it was procured.
- (A) What is the benefit of the purchase. If there is an ROI, describe the ROI and how calculated. For the 2024 group licensing process, FLVC negotiated pricing for 149 different products from 32 separate vendors, totaling almost \$2.5 million. The cost avoidance, which is the sum of the total savings by all institutions for participating in the group licensing process rather than buying these products separately, is almost \$20 million.
- **(B)** How does the purchase support the Strategic Business Plan. The Broward College library services provides resources and services that assist student success by making it easier for students to access unique resources and local institutional archives to complete related assignments and research which supports the Broward College's Social Enterprise Plan, specifically to overcome the digital divide under guaranteed access to higher education and customize learning experiences through multiple modalities under empower student development.
- (C) If applicable, what is the rationale for the use of piggybacks, existing contract extensions, bid waivers in lieu of the College conducting a competitive solicitation. The College used the bid waiver exemption provided for the library resources in accordance with FLDOE Rule 6A-14.0734 and College Procedure 6AHx2-
