Re: January 2025 Warrants

1) PAYROLL: A historical analysis indicates that the January 2025 payroll warrants are higher than the prior year and lower than the six, twelve, and twenty-four-month averages. This increase is primarily attributed to Broward College's participation in the State Group Insurance Plan (SGIP). The decrease is mainly due to the accrued leave payouts and job architecture salary increase from the prior years.
