Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize the standard agreement (purchase order) with Christine Stiller dba New Horizons Coaching & Consulting for facilitation services for the BC LEAD program Cohorts 6 & 7. Fiscal Impact: \$2,000.00

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The purpose of this contract is to provide facilitation for one of the modules within the BC LEAD program for two cohorts. The Broward College's Leadership Empowerment And Development Program (BC LEAD) is now in its fifth cohort. This contract will enable us to continue to give our internal leaders the tools they need to continue to grow in their current leadership role and beyond. 20-25 internal leaders take part in each cohort.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there is no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. One quote was obtained by the requesting department to identify the best value for the required commodity or service.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting? Yes.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? FD100, CC0289, GLC: 65000 - Professional Fees.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes. The decision to enter into the agreement was based on the expectation that the continuation of this program will lead to enhanced leadership skills, improved team performance, and greater efficiency across the institution, as the participants represent a cross section of our leadership.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded and how? Yes, the return on investment was met. The facilitation provided assisted in the development of the participants in the area of composure, problem solving & conflict resolution, ensuring effective leadership during important projects across our institution. Our Administrators have developed stronger leadership skills even when under pressure, which has improved their ability to manage teams and projects effectively. This has led to better decision-making and increased productivity.

Does this directly or indirectly feed one of the Social Enterprise tactics and how? Yes, this contract indirectly feeds one of the Social Enterprise tactics by supporting talent activation. By developing the leaders in the BC LEAD program, the college ensures effective leadership in critical areas, ultimately benefiting the college community, including students, faculty, and staff.
