Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize the Standard Agreement (Purchase Order) with the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training (IADLEST) for membership and renewal dues for FY2024-2025 for Public Safety Pathway/Institute of Public Safety. 1. Describe the purpose of this purchase of goods, services, information technology, construction, or use of space. The purpose and benefit of this membership is to keep up to date with the training of other National Law Enforcement Training Centers. As a member, the Dean of the Institute can communicate directly with other agencies on a national level to determine the best course of action regarding Institute training and discuss any topics brought forth by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission.
