



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize a standard agreement (purchase order) with the Florida Criminal Justice Training Center Directors' Association (FCJTCD) for membership and renewal dues for FY 2024-2025 for Public Safety Pathway/Institute of Public Safety. Fiscal Impact: \$50.00

What is the purpose of this contract, and why is it needed? The purpose and benefit of this membership is to keep up to date with the Florida State Statutes and the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission standards put forth by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. The Dean of the Public Safety Pathway/Institute of Public Safety is also a Training Center Director Association (TCDA) Executive Board member and must attend the Criminal Justice Training Center Director meetings.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. Membership dues, per the Florida Statute 119.01(3) requires that all financial, business and membership records held by the organization in relation to the individual(s) or organization(s) for whom a purchase order is being issued are to be considered public records and shall be subject to the provisions of Florida Statute 119.07.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees Meeting? Yes. The Institute budgets for this membership every year.

What fund, cost center, and line item(s) were used? FD100, CC0090, and GLC64500.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded and how? As in the past, the ROI has been exceeded since the knowledge and insight gained while attending member meetings is invaluable to the development of the training at the Institute.
