## 1. Prepare for April 10th meeting in O'Neill, NE

Ownership Linkage will conduct a meeting in O'Neill following the Board of Governors meeting on April 10th. Four to six students will be invited to join the Board of Governors for lunch. Ownership Linkage activities will begin at 3:00 p.m. and will be held in the shop area of the O'Neill Extended Campus. Superintendents, principals, and business/industry leaders from Keya Paha, Rock, Brown, Knox, and Holt counties will be invited to attend.
