1. Content Review (CR) – Review policy content and provide suggestions for revisions.
 - a. [EL-06](#) Asset Protection – Policy content was reviewed and there are no suggestions for revision. The Committee requested that a review of the Monitoring Report Summary document be included as a standing agenda item for their future meetings.
 - b. [GP-10](#) Board Code of Conduct – Policy content was reviewed and there are no suggestions for revision.
2. Board Self-Evaluation (BSE) – Review and determine whether the Board has been practicing.
 - a. GP-10 Board Code of Conduct – The Board Self-Evaluation of the policy was discussed and completed. The Committee requested that a copy of the previously completed BSE for each policy be included for reference during future self-evaluations. The Board Self-Monitoring Action Plan will also be reviewed at each meeting, and outstanding action items will be taken to the Board.
3. [GP-14](#) Special Rules of Order – Suggested revision of item 15. to accommodate use of online voting capability in the *OnBoard* board meeting solution.
 - The proposed policy change was reviewed and discussed and will move forward to the December Board meeting for First Reading.
 - An error was also discovered in item 1.2.3.1 regarding the length of time individuals can speak during the public comment period. The policy states that five minutes are allowed, but current practice has been to allow three minutes. The Committee recommends changing the policy to align with the current practice of allowing three minutes to speak during public comment. The recommendation will be taken to the Board for discussion and First Reading if approved.
