
# EARLY COLLEGE ACCESS PROJECT (ECAP)

Goal: Expand access to Early College for all high school students, which will increase the college-going rate in Nebraska.

The 20-county region is divided into three zones, with each area hosting its own Early College Navigator.

Navigators will support students' success in Early College by offering ongoing outreach, providing student advisement, and delivering general support.





## NEBRASKA MATH READINESS PROJECT (NMRP)



The Nebraska Math Readiness Project (NMRP) is designed to bridge the gap between high school and college math, ensuring that students are better prepared and more likely to succeed in their post-secondary education.

\*\*Level I: Pre-Alg. Level II: Elem. Alg. Level III: Int. Alg. & Technical Math\*\*

The benefits are clear:

- No remedial math in college students can start directly in credit-earning math courses or even have completed the necessary college math.
- A self-paced, blended learning approach making it accessible and tailored to each student's needs.
- Higher chances of college success removing a major hurdle that prevents students from completing their degree.
- Free Grant funded

#### **DATA**

#### In 3 years at Northeast:

4 schools to 18 schools (350% growth)

Collaborate with Little Priest Tribal College

22 students to 168 students (approx/year)

#### In 7 years at Northeast:

429 credit hours = \$53,715 SAVED

#### Last year alone:

321 credit hours = \$41,088 <u>SAVED</u>

74% enrolled in college

\*\*70% in a Nebraska college

72% persisted to 2nd year




