Petition 21-P-1584 was presented at the February Zoning Board of Appeals meeting but was recessed until the March Zoning Board meeting which will be after the Lee County Board has the final vote on Petition 21-PC-65 for a text amendment to add the three commercial districts; C-1, Neighborhood Office and Business, C-2, Planned Office and Business, and C-3, General Business. commercial use for MINIWAREHOUSE.

An update was read to the Zoning Board of Appeals members on the progress being made at the Candy Factory, a gentlemen's club located at 2849 US Rt. 30. The new owner is preparing to demolish two buildings on site and then work with the Lee County Health Department on the septic defects on the property. In August, 2021, the owner anticipated the club opening June, 2022.
