- I. <u>Call to Order</u> Meeting was called to order at 11:19 a.m., by Vice Chair Tom Kitson.

Topics discussed during attendance:

- Paul Rudolphi reported the following information from the Treasurer's Office:
 - \circ \$84 million in property taxes have been collected so far this year.
 - The County is roughly \$2 million short of the total collection projected.
 - Roughly 1,800 certified tax collection notices were sent out.
 - The annual tax sale will be on October 30th.

- Jeremy wanted to thank all the Department Heads for diligently working with himself, Paul Rudolphi, Reid Mitchell, and the Finance Committee, to arrive at the proposed balanced budget that has been added to the October County Board agenda.
- He encouraged the committee to check out the Old Courthouse lawn. Several trees were taken down and others were trimmed. The company donated several magnolia trees to replace the trees they took down.
- He reported that in the economic development realm, there were over 28 active potential projects within Lee County. He acknowledged that not all the projects were likely to come to fruition, but those that did would bring in revenues and increase County service.
