#### XV. New Business:

A. Ordinance: Lee County Health Department Food Ordinance (hold over until November)

<u>Motion to hold over</u> the Ordinance for the Lee County Health Department Food Ordinance until the November Meeting. <u>Moved</u> by Mr. Koppien, <u>Second</u> by Ms. Naylor. Ms. White made comments about the Ordinance and the changes that were made to the Food Code to comply with the new State codes. <u>Motion carried</u> unanimously by voice vote.

B. Ordinance: 2024 (FY25) Levy (hold over until November)

Motion to hold over Ordinance 2024 (FY25) Levy. Moved by Mr. Kitson. Second by Ms. Naylor. Administrator Englund spoke about the Levy. Total request is \$9,439,552 Million which is \$680,172 or 7.77% more than last year. The increase is primarily due to, a significant increase in the estimated new property with an assessed value of \$45.000, 000 Million. The county's proposed 2024 tax rate will be approximately \$0.8497 per hundred dollars of EAV, up from \$0.8228 in 2023. For a median price home valued at \$150,000 this would result in an annual estimated tax bill increase of \$11.82. Actual increase on the tax base is 3.4%. The 7.7% is the full capture with new construction tax base coming in. Mr. Schielein made a statement about the increase in head counts, one being a new employee for State's Attorney Office and a new patrol officer for the Sheriff's Department and the other being a newly created position of a Human Resource Officer. Ms. Shippert spoke on her concerns about the red tape with hiring an Human Resource Officer. Chairman Olson spoke about the need of the Officer. It is still in the discussion phase. Englund spoke of his concerns and the need of this position.

C. Ordinance: FY2025 Budget (hold over until November)

Motion to hold over the FY2025 Budget. Moved by Mr. Bivins. Second by Ms. Dallas. Financial Advisor Mitchell spoke on the budget changes from last year. Biggest change is in the personal property replacement tax. Notification from the State is that the county is going to receive 65% of what the county received in the previous year. This year the amount is expected to be around \$700,000 compared to the previous amount of \$1.5 Million. Ms. Shippert had a question pertaining to the departments and who has the biggest change. Mitchell spoke about the different departments that are under Union Contract Negotiations this year. Those departments are the Treasurer, the County Clerk's and the Circuit Clerk's Offices. Ms. Shippert

also wanted to know how Lee County compares to other county's salary base. Mitchell made a statement about in the future we could do a comparison.
