- **Property:** Property Chair Tucker reported that a draft of the roofing bid specifications were provided in the agenda packet; a few clarifications need to be complete before releasing it in hopes to have it out by the beginning of the new year.

- **Public Education/Training:** Education Chair Knipple reported that Telecommunicators McCoy and Ehlers attended an Advance Police Dispatch course in Addison, IL earlier in the month. TC Ehlers provided an overview of the course topics and takeaways that he felt were beneficial to share. Jes indicated that after being on the job for a period of time, classes such as this puts an enhanced perspective back into the day- to-day activities to give a bit of a "reset" of the job. She provided a summary of TC Ehlers report. Cross discipline meetings between dispatch, law and fire were found to be beneficial in other areas. The course was put on by NENA.

- Legislation: Chair Koppien gave an overview of the battery backup scenario. Language should be considered and put in place reference activity regarding battery storage facilities. There was discussion about standards, storage, location and hazards.

• New Business: TC Laura Enlow is retiring effective December 1<sup>st</sup>. TC Dylan Ehlers has accepted a lateral position in Marshall County and his last day will be November 28<sup>th</sup>. Leslie Davidson has been hired to replace TC Enlow and has been in training for over a month with approximately 5 months left in the training environment before she is released. A position has been offered to fill TC Ehlers seat; awaiting background, psychological evaluation and physical before a hire date is determined. Additional one of the two Communications Training Officers is scheduled to be on maternity leave towards the end of December and will be out for approximately 3 months. Staffing levels in the ECC will be at a minimum from December, 2024 through March, 2025, potential longer pending TC training statuses.

AT&T outages continue to occur, and Director Dallas has escalated the issue to the 3<sup>rd</sup> tier level as a chronic issue with no resolution. 9-1-1 calls are rerouting to Ogle County (wireless and VoIP) and IL Valley Regional Dispatch (landline) as designed; however, Intrado/AT&T should be seeing and reporting the issue prior to the reroute and instead, the issue is noted by Ogle and Lee Counties before notification is made by the telco to the affected PSAPs. The outages continue to be investigated as the 9-1-1 circuits bounce in and out of service to determine if it is an AT&T or a local telco issue. Hudson questioned if the FCC is involved; FCC has been as well as Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator. Hudson asked if this is the State issued mandate to migrate to the AT&T ESInet; Director Dallas advised – "yes".
