BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

The Board of Regents sets a minimum stipend for graduate assistants each year. To receive full compensation for a semester, graduate assistants must work the entire semester. Similarly, to receive full compensation for the four-week summer session, they must work the entire session. If a graduate assistant does not complete the full semester or summer session, the stipend may be prorated accordingly.

DSU, SDSMT, and SDSU currently waive tuition for their graduate assistants and fellows as compensation for their work; therefore, the salary minimum does not apply to those three institutions.

IMPACT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Board has traditionally adjusted the minimum stipend for graduate assistants in line with the rate of increase in resident graduate tuition, rounded to the nearest dollar. For FY26, tuition increased by 2.9%, so the stipend amount will be increased by the same percentage.
